
The **ABCs of Customs Brokerage** provides entry-level workers with the skills and knowledge equivalent to one year of experience as a customs specialist, providing the opportunity to earn national certification as a Certified Customs Specialist (CCS) through the National Customs Brokers and Forwarders Association of America's National Educational Institute.

Developed by Mullins International Solutions, the **ABCs of Customs Brokerage** is a 72-hour (nine-day) course that provides career advancement in customs brokering and international trade. These positions generally start around \$15 per hour and can increase with experience and licensing as a Customs Broker.

Students passing the course will be eligible to sit for the National Customs Brokers & Forwarders Educational Institute Certified Customs Specialist exam.

Space is limited to 20 individuals. Applicants must have state ID, high school diploma (or GED), basic computer skills and resume.
