PURPOSE:

Public Hearing

Subdivision Regulation Amendment (SRA) 18-02, Administrative Subdivision - Signature Business Headquarters, lead sponsor District Council at the request of the County Executive, was introduced on April 10, 2018. An accompanying Zoning Text Amendment to create Signature Business Headquarters as a new limited use on Commercial Residential (CR) zoned properties is being introduced as a separate agenda item.

SRA 18-02 would allow another category under which an applicant can file an administrative subdivision plan in place of a preliminary plan for a Signature Business Headquarters. The Planning Director can approve an administrative subdivision plan under an expedited process without Planning Board review.

A Planning, Housing, and Economic Development Committee worksession on SRA 18-02 is tentatively scheduled for May 17, 2018.

1	Sec. 1. Chapter 50 is amended as follows:

5 6 7 8	The subdivider may file an administrative subdivision plan application instead of a preliminary plan under the following circumstances. The Director must review the necessary technical requirements of the administrative subdivision plan under Section 4.3.

10 11 12	E. Subdivision application for property to be used as Signature Business Headquarters under Section 3.5.8.D of the Zoning Ordinance. A lot or lots created for a Signature Business Headquarters may be approved, if:
13 14 15	1. The Planning Board approves a Signature Business Headquarters plan under Section 59-7.3.5, including a finding of adequate public facilities under the standards of Section 50-4.3.J, before approval of the plat;
16 17	 any required road dedications, or covenants for future dedications, and associated public utility easements are shown on the record plat;
18 19 20	3. forest conservation, stormwater management, and environmental protection requirements, if applicable, are satisfied before approval of the plat; and
21 22	4. all special protection area requirements are satisfied before approval of the plat, if the subject property is located in a special protection area.
