



2019 Annual Scholarship for Continuing Education

Submission of a COMPLETE APPLICATION: Must be postmarked May 1, 2019

- A BLL Board-appointed committee will select recipient(s) from the pool of applicants each year.
- The Board will award a minimum of one Scholarship for Continuing Education per year.
- The recipient(s) shall be chosen from among those applicants who are eligible to apply and who also adhere to the submission requirements with a completed application.
- The monetary value of the award may vary based on the financial health of the League.

For 2019, a minimum of one award, consisting of a one-time \$1,000.00 scholarship, will be paid to the chosen recipient.

For eligibility, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Must be accepted and enrolled in a program of continuing education from an accredited institution for the Fall of 2019.
2. Must be a graduating Senior with an average of 85 or better.
3. Must have played a minimum of four years as a member of Brick National/Brick Little League.
4. Must exemplify hard work, determination & a willingness to contribute selflessly, as shown by recommendations.
