The inaugural Vice Chair for Research will be responsible for guiding the development and expansion of the growing research programs at Dayton Children's, taking full advantage of the Hospital's extraordinary faculty, staff and resources as well as the opportunities for partnership with the faculty of Wright State University in other departments. The ideal candidate will be an established investigator and emerging leader in health services research, a multidisciplinary field of scientific investigation that addresses how health technologies, organizational structures and processes, personal behaviors, and social factors can affect access to healthcare, the quality and cost of healthcare, and ultimately, health and well-being. He/She will be committed to optimizing the integration of research and improvement to accelerate the application of discoveries into care and policy resulting in new and better systems for healthcare delivery. The Vice Chair will champion the application of secondary data analysis and systems improvement methods across a broad range of areas including primary and subspecialty care, communities and public health settings to improve the health outcomes of children, families and communities.

Candidates should have an MD or DO degree and will have served in a program leadership role within a school of medicine. We seek candidates who are accomplished investigators respected for excellence in research related to diseases in childhood and nationally recognized as scholars. The Vice Chair will be an academic leader qualified for appointment as Associate Professor or Professor of Pediatrics at Wright State. It is considered of utmost importance that the candidate selected demonstrate great

compassion and collaboration with others and share Dayton Children's other values which include patient safety first, innovation, ownership and good resource stewardship. The successful candidate must be kind and considerate. He/She must bring out the best in people around them and encourage open discussion and sharing of opinions in a professional and safe environment.
