The 2021 Washington State Science and Engineering Fair is right around the corner. We have 100 judges signed up as of today. We need close to 200 by fair day.

Volunteering to judge at WSSEF is a rewarding and uplifting experience that is best seen when a student participant is presenting their science project and realizes someone both understands and cares about their effort.

WSSEF is splitting the Fair into two separate weekend events for 2021. Grades 9 – 12 students will be judged on March 26 & 27, 2021 (Friday & Saturday). Grades 1 – 8 will be April 16 & 17, 2021 (Friday & Saturday). WSSEF hopes you will volunteer for both worthy student events.

WSSEF 2021 will be virtual again this year using Zoom meetings and judging is from the comfort of your own home.

Being virtual does not reduce the need for judges. To properly judge the students 200 Judges are needed for each weekend. Please, tell your friends and colleagues about the opportunity to judge at WSSEF.

WSSEF is working on an upgraded judging system to give our students more times to interact with the judges and receive your encouragement. This involves a designated Judging Team Lead. Following student judging, the Team Lead guides discussions to determine final placement scores, enter the information into Google sheets and are trained to answer technical questions about the STEM Wizard software. Multiple training sessions will occur during the fall. We need Team Leads to volunteer now. If interested, please send a note to Mike Huey, WSSEF Head Judge at headjudge@wssef.org

Time commitments are 2 training sessions prior to the fair lasting 30- 60 minutes and all day of the fair.
