All valedictorians and salutatorians in the Pittsburgh Public Schools system are guaranteed admission to one of our five Pitt campuses. All eligible students will receive a minimum of \$2,000 in scholarship funding or the University will meet the full financial need of any Pell Grant eligible Pittsburgh Public Scholars.

Eligibility for this program is typically determined after third quarter grades are available and valedictorian and salutatorian status can be officially confirmed. If you have any questions about your eligibility for the Pittsburgh Public Scholars program, please talk to your school counselor.
