



The Fiscal Burden of Illegal Immigration on Pennsylvania

How much does it cost taxpayers in the Keystone State?

An estimated **180,000**  illegal aliens live in Pennsylvania.

Illegal aliens cost taxpayers **\$1.4 billion**  in state & local costs,

But they only pay an estimated **\$49 million**  in taxes collected by the state;

Leaving a burden of nearly **\$1.3 billion**  for Pennsylvania taxpayers.

Illegal Immigration Cost Pennsylvania Taxpayers

\$1.3 Billion  in 2010.

That amounts to a burden of **\$297**  per household headed by a U.S. citizen.
