


New Assessment Center Online System Announcement and Trainings


The first assessments that will be available in the new assessment center:

- Adult Acuity Instrument (AAI)
- State-funded Behavior Add-on Request
- Self-Medication assessment

On March 24^{th,} you will be able to access the Assessment Center from the individual record by selecting the tile for Assessment Center like how you access the Level of Care or Individual Transfer Requests. (See Screen shot below)



All assessments will be available on one page for you to view listings, open for a detailed view, and you will have the ability to submit new entries. (See screen shot below)
