Proposed 2023 Capital Improvement Project At-A-Glance

On Thursday, December 14, 2023, Batavia City School District residents will have an opportunity to vote on a proposed capital improvement project that is designed to modernize our instructional spaces, optimize our building grade-level configuration, and address high-priority facilities needs throughout our District. The *BCSD Reimagined* project will also prepare our school buildings for planned grade-level reconfigurations to maximize equity, opportunity, and educational outcomes for our entire student population.

It was a priority of the Board and our leadership team that this capital improvement project comes at no additional cost to our Batavia community. Through diligent analysis of our student enrollment projections, academic enrichment opportunities, and asset preservation needs, along with dutiful financial planning and optimization of State Building Aid, we are able to propose the *BCSD Reimagined* project with <u>no annual increase to taxpayers</u>.


In the schools: Two public information meetings will provide an opportunity to learn more and ask questions about the project. Information will also be on display in the school lobby areas.

Project Financing

The *BCSD Reimagined* project will be paid for using a combination of available State Building Aid and funds from the District's Capital Reserve, which is designated to be used specifically for capital improvements. As a result of careful planning and budget implementation, this project will have **NO ADDITIONAL TAX INCREASE** for district residents and businesses.


