I invite you to apply for a Community Forest Agreement (CFA), as determined by the Minister on January 26, 2021. Please consider this letter your official invitation to apply for CFA K3W. One of the application requirements is the proposal of a CFA area. This area must be supported in writing by the District Manager Josh Pressey, Quesnel Forest District, before the application is submitted. The volume offered is 69 850 m³ (42 850 m³ Coniferous and 27 000 m³ Deciduous Partition) and only the area shown to support this volume will be acceptable. The term of the license will be 25 years and in accordance with *The Forest Act* and the Community Tenures Regulation, may be replaced.

After receiving District Manager support of your proposed CFA area, please return your completed application within three months to Regional Executive Director, c/o Timber Tenures Manager, 441 Columbia Street, Kamloops, British Columbia, V2C 2T3.
