**Subject:** Lease – Bailey Helicopters

### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this report is to obtain Council approval to enter into a five-year lease with Bailey Helicopter for the use of office space in the Operations Building at the Quesnel Regional Airport.

## **SUMMARY**

- Bailey Helicopter is interested in leasing Room 105 in the Operations Building at the Airport.
- The revenue generated from the lease of office space is modest but there is considerable benefit to the airport that will realized as a result of having Bailey Helicopter base their operations at the airport as it will generate additional air traffic movements and fuel sales.
- The space to be leased is approximately 12.5 square meters.
- Staff have negotiated an agreement with Bailey Helicopter that is based on similar agreements with other tenants at the airport.
- The fee for the leased space works out to approximately \$13.64/ square foot which is comparable with other leases the City has and is considered 'fair market value' for the space.

#### RECOMMENDATION

THAT COUNCIL enter into the attached five-year Lease with Bailey Helicopters for use of approximately 12.5 square metres of office space at the Quesnel Regional Airport;

AND THAT the Corporate Administrator be authorized to execute such documentation as required to complete the Agreement.

# FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The lease is expected to generate \$1,800 in direct revenue for the City.
