Putting Data to Work

The CTE Outcomes Survey (CTEOS) is a survey of former California community college students. CTEOS provides a wealth of data that cannot be found anywhere else, including:



A Voice for Students

Former students provide valuable feedback about your college CTE programs



Hourly Wages

CTEOS contains data on earnings per hour--a useful measure to see if students are getting raises.



Employment Status

Students report whether the job they secured is full-time or part-time, and permanent or temporary/seasonal.



Job Similarity to Program of Study

CTE programs train students for specific jobs. Students report how similar their job is to their program of study.



Job Search Length



Satifaction Rate



Inclusivity

CTEOS captures important employment data from people who are excluded from other data sources (e.g., those without SSNs, self-employed workers)
