DR. ALFRED O. HEATH JOINS THE SRMC STAFF CONTINUING TO RECEIVE THE PFIZER COVID-19 VACCINE

St. Thomas, US Virgin Islands - Today Frontline healthcare workers at the Schneider Regional Medical Center continued their efforts to receive the COVID-19 vaccine, which was recently approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The Virgin Islands Department of Health along with SRMC received the first of the territory's allocation of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine last week.

Nurses, doctors, and even one of the territory's most well-known physicians Dr. Alfred O. Heath took the historic step in the world's unprecedented undertaking to control and end the COVID-19 pandemic.

After taking the vaccine Dr. Heath stood triumphantly and celebrated along with his fellow healthcare workers at SRMC. According to the VI Department of Health about 260 Virgin Islanders have received the vaccine so far.

"This is a great day for our families, frontline workers, and the Virgin Islands as a whole. Our frontline essential hospital workers have gone above and beyond during this pandemicincluding stepping up today to receive vaccines. Once the vaccine becomes available to all it is my hope that everyone takes full advantage of this opportunity." said Dr. Heath.


Nationwide the CDC estimates people age 65 and older have accounted for 8 in 10 deaths attributed to the coronavirus.

"Older adults are a major priority as well. We are at greater risk than younger people of death or serious complications from COVID-19. I am here today to lead by example. If you're in the elderly population of the Virgin Islands like I am, get vaccinated."
