CONCERNED ABOUT PAYING FUTURE AND UNPAID BILLS?



ELIGIBLE EXPENSES INCLUDE

- Unpaid past due rent and utility services incurred after March 13, 2020. This even includes at a previous residence.
- Unpaid current and future rent (up to 3 months at a time)
- Up to 15 months of rent and/or utilities
- Eligible utility costs include: electricity; energy costs (fuel, oil, propane); water and sewer; and internet service (up to \$50 per month).
- Other eligible expenses may include: reasonable relocation expenses, security deposits and reasonable late fees. *These costs will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis*.
