
Wildwood Park Development Plan



<u>Development Timeline</u>

Next Steps

- Designing and Constructing Mountain Bike Trails and a Bicycle Skills Course (Construction to be completed in 2022)
- Complete Design of Trail Connections that will include sections of boardwalk and bridges. (Design to be complete in early 2022 and Construction of some portions will be complete in late 2022)
- Design of an Observation Tower that will be located in the lake. (Design will be complete in early 2022, fundraising efforts for construction are ongoing)
- Design and build a restroom facility and pavilion improvements (2022-23)
- Construct additional parking lot along Old Pactolus Rd (2022)
