Effective Immediately:

KENTUCKY TORNADOES – 6 ADDITIONAL COUNTIES GRANTED INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE

On December 12, 2021, with [DR-4630](#), the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) declared that federal disaster aid with individual assistance has been made available to counties in Kentucky to supplement state and local recovery efforts in the areas affected by severe storms, straight-line winds, flooding, and tornadoes from **December 10, 2021, and continuing.**

- On December 16, 2021 with [Amendment No. 1](#), FEMA granted Individual Assistance to 6 additional counties.
