The Curriculum, Assessment and Student Success Policy Branch and the French Language Teaching and Learning Branch are looking for curriculum writers who will support revisions to *The Ontario Curriculum: Science, Grade 9.* The ministry is seeking classroom teachers and coordinator /consultants/ instructional leaders, with relevant experience and expertise, to apply for curriculum revision writing teams. The successful applicants will participate in virtual writing sessions to draft proposed revisions to the curriculum.

Application Process:

Candidates making a submission to become a curriculum writer should submit documentation demonstrating their skills, qualifications and expertise, as requested under the Technical Response Evaluation section of the Invitation to Quote. Documentation could include a cover letter, resume and/or other documents to ensure all the points in the evaluation can be addressed.

Time and Location:

• **Content Contribution:** Ten days of asynchronous curriculum writing and editing activities scheduled for weekends and weeknights between September 25 and October 24.

Writers will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Certified teachers who are currently in good standing or retired with the Ontario College of Teachers;
- Educators and leaders representing English-language/French-language Catholic or public school boards located in diverse urban and rural areas in all regions across the province;
- Demonstrated subject matter expertise in secondary science, experience with developing curriculum or curriculum related resources and/or expertise in assessment and evaluation;
- Demonstrated knowledge, skill and expertise in delivering high quality programs and developing effective resources to support Ministry of Education policies in schools and boards;
- Demonstrated knowledge and or experience in innovative or alternative models of Grade 9
 programming including, de-streamed teaching, and culturally responsive equitable and anti-racist
 education practices and approaches.
- Educators and leaders representing the diversity of the student population and the population of the province, including Black, Indigenous and other under-represented communities;
- Educators and leaders bringing diverse perspectives including equity, diversity, inclusivity and/or Indigenous perspective, such as lived experiences with First Nations, Métis and/or Inuit communities;
- Demonstrated knowledge, skill and expertise in Special Education, French-language learning and/or English-language learning;
- Available for the full 10 days of writing.

Remuneration:

Writers will receive payment of \$300/day. Note, due to the current health restrictions, all writing sessions will take place virtually. Writers will require access to the internet and a computer.
