“Cancer Prevention and Care among Racial Minority Populations: Integrating Research, Teaching, & Practice”

Yuqi Guo is a Ph.D. candidate in the School of Social Work at The University of Alabama. Her research focuses on public health management of infectious and chronic diseases. Recently, Yuqi received a \$40,000 grant from the American Cancer Society to support her dissertation and research agenda. Her dissertation aims to analyze factors associated with adherence to cervical cancer prevention guidelines. She aims to use telehealth technology to deliver knowledge of cancer prevention and care to those who have limited access to health care services. Currently, she is working on multiple community-based participatory research projects, clinical trial design research projects, and secondary data analyses. During her Ph.D. program, she submitted 19 manuscripts (15 published and 4 under review). She conducted 33 presentations at national and international conferences. Also, she has demonstrated excellence in teaching. She has independently taught courses in policy, theory, practice, and end-of-life care.
